COLONIA'S TRUTH, never far back, alternated up front, was headed nearing the furlong marker then came back to outfinish ALUMA after that one ducked out in deep stretch. ALUMA, in traffic early, challenged off the inside in the second turn, gained the advantage nearing the furlong marker, ducked out under a left-handed stick soon after then could not get back to the winner. FOLLOWING A STEWARDS' INQUIRY REGARDING THE STRETCH RUN, ALUMA WAS DISQUALIFIED AND PLACED THIRD. PROPER CIELO, a forward factor, waited in traffic in the second turn, was bothered then clipped heels when ALUMA ducked out in the stretch then went evenly to the wire. ROSE OF CIMARRON moved closer four wide in the second turn, was bothered slightly a furlong out and also was going evenly late. TOWER OF ANGELS, in tight at the start, improved her position. CRYPTONESIAN came in at the start then tired from her early efforts. LA MERCED lacked a rally. TREETOP ANGEL also came up empty while wide. CABACHON CUT remained back. BUSY NATIVE, a pace factor for a half, stopped. BABY BABY BABY showed little. GRAB N GO finished far back.
