RICHEST HALF broke well, narrowly showed the way into the turn off the rail, shook clear when straightened for home, maintained daylight late under steady handling. RULING STAR stumbled at the start, recovered and moved up the rail to contest the pace, fell back off the winner in upper stretch, moved off the inside, held the place. HARRY THE PRINCE void of early foot, roused for the drive, coming late down the middle part of the strip. COLD STONE STEVE within striking distance, failed to muster any late gain while between foes. GOLDEN GUS trailed for a half, lacked a significant late bid. CANYON DE ORO tired in the drive. TWINING DREAM faded.
