MOVING FEVER off the pace, in traffic late in the turn when moving a bit closer, quick move to challenge and clear off the rail when straightened for home, clear, driving. GOLDLEAFED MIRROR dueled early through a rapid opening quarter, shook briefly clear upper stretch, no match for the winner, comfortably second best. KYLERS MIDGE settled in the second flight, evenly paced through the stretch, finished best of the rest. RICH MUSIQUE vied off the inside, quick pace, weakened in the drive. JENNY'S PRINCESS well back for a half, not much of a rally. GOTTA JIBOO five wide turning for home, had nothing left for the drive. BONITA ROSE last away, far back, no factor. CANDY HAZE within striking distance, backed up through the stretch.
