JOUBERT'S GOLD broke alertly, vied up front early toward the inside, shook clear in the turn, drew out stretch under token encouragement. PACIFIC STAR lacked speed, checked late in the turn in some traffic, got through between foes upper stretch, finished willingly for place while not a threat to the winner. SILVER BAYER well back for a half, came five wide out of the turn, moved out wider upper stretch, closed some ground to be up for the show late. UNBRIDLED ELTEMPO within striking distance, missed the show in lacking a winning response. NEVILL'S MISTAKE allowed to settle, came four wide out of the turn, did not have enough for the show while between foes. HERECOMESTHEMANNOW vied early, chased through the turn, gave way in the drive. NEED MONEY DAD failed to menace. WATCH PAT tired along the inside. ROCK' N FIRE broke in the air, trailed throughout.
