CLASSIC GAIT outrun in the early going, saved ground through the turn, moved out, split foes late, in time. TIBI in the second flight, came into the stretch off the inside, roused for the drive, not enough for the win in the late going, clear of the rest. MONITA pressed early, took over turning for home, drifted nearing the furlong marker, faltered in the late going. DIVINE DESIGN well clear in the early going in setting the pace, vied out of the turn, weakened drive. MCCLEES CREEK lacked speed, off the inside, improved position, no real threat. SAFE N RICH forwardly placed out in the strip, tired in the drive. PINK MARTINI steadied at the start, trailed for a half, picked off a couple of tiring foes. SHERRY'S TIGER bobbled, broke to the inside, had little left for the drive. WARRENS GRINDSTONE failed to menace. DADDYS FOUR QUEENS tired in the drive. SASS IN THE CITY was finished early.
