## Footnotes

CABE outrun in the early going, advanced four out to five wide in the turn, set down for the drive, closed with good resolve on the outside to be in time. HALF A WELL within striking distance early while racing outside, lodged a four wide bid into the lane, brushed with BLUSHING ROMEO in upper stretch, outfinished that rival for the place spot while being outsicked for the win late. BLUSHING ROMEO also never far back while between horses, advanced and challenged late in the turn, narrowly showed the way past the furlong marker, gave ground grudgingly in the late going. ZARBY'S HOME forwardly placed along the inside, firm restraint along the inside, bid into lane, flattened out a bit in the late going. DEPUTY FOREST asked early, behind the pace, four wide and in traffic into the stretch, steered out and displayed some interest in the late going. BRASSY BOY void of early foot, six wide into the lane, improved position a bit late while widest at the wire. BE LIKE MS. D. off the pace while racing along the inside, in traffic while continuing along the inside, roused, came up empty late. DESTINARE brushed at the start, raced back off the pace, came three wide out of the turn when behind a wall of horses, traffic midstretch, finished up evenly when clear late. MY NEPHEW MATT broke on top, showed the way early, vied out of the turn, continued to contest the issue past the furlong marker, gave way in the late going. TRICKYEXPECTATIONS stumbled at the start, unseated rider.
