Footnotes

DELAGO off the early pace, boxed inside backstretch, moved out a bit, split foes turning for home, angled out, four wide into the lane, finished up willingly to prove best. D' WILDCARD last away, trailed for five furlongs, ranged up on the outside to challenge with a bold move turning for home, narrowly showed the way past the furlong marker, proved no match for the winner late. DEFLATIONARY FEARS within striking distance behind the leaders, advanced three wide far turn, dueled into the lane, weakened a bit, lasted for the show. JUMP IN LINE four wide into the first turn, remained within striking distance, five wide into the lane in some traffic, came up empty. HARD NOSED set or forced the pace for five furlongs along the inside, gave way into the far turn. BUILT TO PRECISION also with the pace until the far turn, stopped.
