Footnotes

PLEASANT VOW four wide into the first turn when forwardly placed, remained within striking distance backstretch, ranged up to challenge between rivals and three wide late final turn, drove steadily clear. FORTUNE AFAR allowed to settle off the pace, loomed boldly five wide late in the final turn, lost some ground to the winner into the lane, could not get back to that rival, up for the place. ZELLERS forwardly placed, took over in the three path second turn, headed by the winner upper stretch, drifted, tired a bid, comfortably held the show. COLBERT chased the leader for five furlongs, 4w challenge second turn, little left drive. RALLY POINT void of early foot, set down late in the final turn, displayed a modest amount of late interest. UNYIELDING leapt in the air at the start, raced well back early as a result, improved position while not a serious threat. NOMO' CANDY lacked a late bid. BINGORUN sprint clear soon after the start, set the pace, began to falter when headed late in the second turn. ECONOMIC RECOVERY made little impact off the inside. BITTER TRUTH was finished early.
