LADY SPENCER got clear before a quarter, set the pace toward the inside, headed in midstretch, roused, came back along the rail to prove best. CABINETS INCLUDED settled behind the pace while firmly in hand, continued to rate in the run up the backstretch, moved out, challenged the winner with a furlong remaining, put a head in front, could not match strides with that same foe late. EVA'S NITEHAWK settled off the pace while four wide through the first turn, slow, rally best of the rest. CEBU lacked speed, asked for some run midway on the second turn, steered out five wide turning for home, improved position while not a serious threat. PAID VACATION pressured the pace off the inside, had little left for the drive. KERISMA lacked speed, saved ground to no avail. DIXIE IN PINK rated, moved up to prompt the pace three wide, gave way in the drive. MAINE D'OR last away, remained always back. BIT OF BARBED WIRE raced outside and off the pace, stopped after a half, distanced. SWEET AFLEET was racing back off the pace when she clipped heels and unseated her rider.
