PROCEED BEE four wide and off the pace, continued outside, asked along second turn, late surge to be up late. ANOTHER GEAR prompted the pace off the inside, took over turning for home, clear past the furlong marker, could not contain the winner. COVERT OPS took back, came five wide out of the final turn, mild rally, finished clear of the others. ZENARO got clear soon after the start, showed the way up the backstretch, weakened when headed by the winner exiting the final turn. HARBORPLACE forwardly paced for almost six furlongs, had little left for the stretch run. CHARLIE'S QUEST mid pack early, came six wide into the stretch, failed to rally. TIZ READY remained always back. JACK N JOHN last away, trailed throughout.
