INDIARA outrun early, asked along into the far turn when off the pace, came five wide into the stretch, roused, finished with good energy to be in time. WHYPRINCESSWHY broke well, showed the way into the first turn, larger advantage in the run up the backstretch, continued to maintain a daylight advantage into the stretch, could not contain the winner late, remained clear for the place. GOTTAHOPE lacked speed, lacked clear room while in some traffic in the turn, rallied, brushed late, held show. RIGHT TO RULE forwardly placed off the inside, roused for the drive, closest to the leader midstretch, drifted, weakened. JULIET DEAR void of early foot, in traffic through the turn, three wide into the lane, straightened for home, displayed a modest amount of late interest. LAUREN BROOKE settled off the pace, raced toward the inside turn, lacked room while continuing along the rail through most of the bend, went evenly in the drive. FIND THE HUMOR off the pace, was five wide through the turn, failed to muster a rally. RIDEM UP off a bit slow, remained back throughout. FANTASY BAY four wide in the turn, tired in the drive. STORMING WILDCAT chased for a half, stopped.
