Footnotes

ATTICUS THE MAN allowed the pace to go early, challenged between rivals exiting the final turn, long drive, proved determined in the late going while closest to the inside of the first flight. GRIND in the second flight off the inside, ranged up to challenge three wide turning for home, dueled to the wire, outkicked. PARTY HARD lacked speed, asked along in the second turn, asked along in the three path far turn, moved out to be five wide into the lane, improved position. MISTER H quickly got clear, attempted to rate through a quick opening quarter, continued to hold a long lead into the second turn, briefly vied inside the top two into the lane, weakened, failed to save the show late. JACK KNIFE settled off the pace, evenly into the lane off the inside, no late gain. MOON ON FIRE lacked speed, moved inside, remained well back in the far turn, staged a mild, belated rally. RUNAWAY CRYPTO raced in mid pace, lacked a late kick while racing toward the inside. CALHOUN STONEWALL fell far back, picked off some tiring foes while never a threat. STRANGE OVERTONES closest to the leader for five furlongs, gave way. EISWEIN bobbed slightly at the start, remained always back. SWOROVSKI showed little while racing outside.
