### Footnotes

FICTIONALITY back off the pace and the inside, advanced three wide, bid, took over, drove well clear in a solid effort. MORNING STAR broke out, lacked speed, advance three wide into contention turning for home, bothered nearing the furlong marker when KATIE O. drifted out, finished willingly after recovering to prove second best. SWING IT DISH firmly in hand after breaking with the field, shuffled back toward the inside far turn, moved out, five wide into the lane, displayed some interest to be up for the show. KATIE O. closest to the leader, continued to chase through the turn, was beginning to tire midstretch when he drifted out, continued to weaken. DORN lacked speed, improved into the lane, traffic, angled in midstretch, flattened out late. STEEL CUT within striking distance toward the inside, lacked a closing punch in the drive. LUCKY EIGHT broke sharp, sprinted clear, weakened when headed into the lane. SOUTHERN MAID void of speed, five wide out of the turn, made little impact in the drive. SHUT THE GATE in mid pack early, bit closer while four wide in the turn, drifted in a bit upper stretch, made little impact to the wire. HOLLYWOOD HOTTIE bothered at the start, remained always back. LITTLE STEVIE GIRL trailed throughout in showing little.
