FIREWHIRL broke alertly, got clear, set the pace toward the inside while in hand, remained clear the final furlong while being kept to task. SHE'S ABOVE DA LAW lacked speed while toward the inside, rallied for the place while remaining toward the rail, could do little with the winner late. CHEROKEE PRINCESS forwardly placed, chased the winner into the stretch, also failed to do much with that foe, outfinished for the place. CAROUSING went evenly paced throughout. A P DILLY well off the pace, came five wide out of the final turn, made little in the way of a late run. MISS ECTON STUFF broke in the air and was then pinched back, trailed, swung out six wide exiting the final turn, picked off a few tiring rivals while not a serious threat. DANCINFORABREW was finished early. WINGO chased the winner for a half and stopped. UNCLOUDED DAY was finished after a half.
