**Footnotes**

MONTY HAUL broke alertly, dueled up front while closest to the inside, shook clear of the other speed when straightened for home, held the runner up comfortably safe late. ALANDTOM in the second flight along the inside, shifted out past the furlong marker, roused, slowly getting to the winner late. SCRIVENER'S ERROR off the early pace and the inside, angled out five wide turning for home, mild rally, finished up best of the rest. FULMINATOR dueled up front off the inside for a half, weakened in the drive. SCHMEE one pace throughout while racing off the inside. PALADIN'S FURY in the second flight while between foes, moved a bit closer into the far turn, had little left for the drive. QUOTE TO CASH was never dangerous while racing off the inside. RIGHT NOW remained back throughout. SAM WAYNE void of early foot, never menaced. SUMMER FUN HOUSE forwardly placed, fanned out six wide into the lane, faded through the stretch. CONGRATS EXPRESS off slowly, trailed home.
