Footnotes

COMPETENT dueled up front early closest to the inside, fell back off the leader the middle half mile, roused for the drive three wide, finished with good late energy to prove best. PARODY unhurried early, saved ground, continued back while along the rail into the far turn, waited with three sixteenths remaining, altered course back to the inside, finished willingly up the rail. FALLING KNIFE vied early off the inside, garnered a larger advantage the middle half mile, continued to show the way into the lane, could not last, lost nod for the place. HERO'S EMPIRE void of speed, managed a good gain four wide through the second turn, flattened out the final furlong, finished up evenly. MAC DEHERE off the pace and the inside, dropped toward the rail for the drive, improved position slightly, no real threat. BONAROO vied up front into and through much of the first turn while between rivals, fell back. GUARDED ENTRANCE never a threat while racing four wide in the second turn. RENEWING was finished after a half.
