GOLDEN FRONTIER broke well, vied immediately while three wide, disposed of the other speed turning for home under confident handling, well clear under a steady hand ride to win ridden out. SPIN ZONE vied inside early while closest to the inside, dueled through the turn, proved no match for the winner, clearly second best. MUCHO MACHO UNO behind the pace off the inside, three wide turn, set down for the drive, slowly gaining for the place. BOGIE BOY settled off the pace, lacked a late kick. HAMMER SONG raced in the two path, made little impact down the lane. TURNOFTHECAT vied up front between the top two for three furlongs and began to weaken. WESTERN RANGE off the pace and the inside, failed to respond when asked in the drive. MAC'S SURPRISE off a bit slow, raced back and was never involved in showing little in a dull effort. INSIDE THE BELTWAY off slowly, trailed much of the way. WISKEY N' CLYDE off the pace, raced four wide through the turn, tired in the drive.
