W W RED SQUARE unhurried early, came three wide and in some traffic into the lane, altered course, split foes past the furlong marker, game. LET'SPLAYGORGEIOUS chased the leader, took over in the second turn, shook well clear, could not contain the winner. WICKEN last away, raced back, angled out to be five wide turning for home, staged a belated rally for the show. MISSY MINER within striking distance while off the inside, chased the runner up past the furlong marker, had little left in the late going. REMEMBERYOURPLACE off the inside, asked for some run in the second turn, inside through the stretch, lacked a late punch. SUGAR BRITCHES lacked speed, remained back after racing four wide through the second turn. COUGAR NIGHT bit rank, boxed second turn along the rail, fell back. SMOOTH SEA clear early, showed the way for five furlongs and stopped.
