**Footnotes**

MINER BIRD outrun in the early going, angled out, made a good gain on the outside to take over turning for home, well clear, driving. GENERAL PARTNER also well back off the pace, came six wide turning into the lane, proved no match for the winner, held sway for the place. SGT. EMBLETON settled off the pace toward the inside, waited in traffic late in the final turn, got through soon after, outfinished for the place spot. BEHREN'S LEGACY raced always outside, came five wide out of the final turn, improved position a bit without posing a serious threat. IMATRUBADOR moved closer in the second turn in some traffic, came five wide turning for home, brushed soon after, finished up evenly. SILVER NICKEL forwardly placed, was four wide out of the final turn, was tiring when brushed upper stretch, continued to weaken. TO THE MOON fell back before a half, lacked a bid in the drive. HOUR TEN off slowly, trailed early, was never involved. EAST COAST SWING moved up to alternate for the advantage while outside, gave way. HORIZON POINT broke on top,

set or forced the pace for six furlongs, stopped in the drive. ROWDY TOWN gave way early, fell further back, distanced after losing contact with the field.
