Footnotes

LOOKN MIGHTY FAST with the pace from the start, showed the way through the turn closest to the inside, shook clear when straightened for home in the two path, held the runner up comfortably safe under steady handling. LOVANGO pressured the pace six wide into the turn, five wide out of the bend, could do little with the winner in the drive, remained clear for the place. RANGE WAR vied early while between foes early, fell back a bit into the lane, came back for the show while not a serious threat to the top two. GOALTOGOAL with the pace while also between foes early, fell back off the pace, dropped inside for the drive, outfinished for the show spot while continuing along the rail. BACKTRACK lacked speed, came five wide out of the turn, improved position slightly, no real threat. CHECKSANDBALANCES forwardly placed for a half while four wide, weakened. BAD BIG AL did not menace. MOYER'S POND last away, trailed, picked off a couple of tiring foes while not a serious threat. REPENTER tired while five wide. COWBOY CHARLIE in the first flight, staged a steady retreat.
