Footnotes

RAYMOND'S BREW unhurried in the early going, saved some ground turn, continued inside, rallied up the rail and finished well to be in time. EPIC MATCH set the pace while off the inside, showed the way past the furlong marker, allowed the winner the inside, outkicked at the wire. GOTTA GO GOLD in the second flight toward the inside, moved out to be four wide when moving closer late in the turn, could get no closer in the drive, lasted for the show. REWIRING off the pace, raced four wide and in some traffic in the turn, lost some position into the lane, coming back for the show. SORROWFUL JONES dueled up front while outside the runner up for a half and began to weaken. STORM BOOT LARRY steadied in the early going, fell back, raced three wide in the turn, never dangerous in the drive. FERGUS MAC ROICH in the second group out in the strip, five wide turning for home, lacked a late kick. KELEVRA was always outrun. NOAH'S TRAVELER raced six wide much of the way, tired.
