TACTICAL OFFICER close from the start, chased the leader into the turn, collared that rival and showed the way into the stretch, got clear and held the runner up comfortably safe under steady handling. SUE'S SWEET SIOUX off the pace while well out in the strip, five wide turn, roused with a quarter remaining, slowly closed the gap on the final furlong, clearly second best. RETURNED TO SENDER settled off the pace, steadied slightly along the inside midway on the turn, moved out for the drive, rallied for the show, no match for the top two. DIAMOND D'ORO forwardly placed, three wide into the lane, lacked a winning response. HERE'S FAT lacked speed, continued well back through the turn, improved position while no real threat. FAST CITY showed the way in the early going two path, gave way when headed by the winner late in the turn. EVA'S NITEHAWK was not a factor. PURE APPLAUSE lacked a bid. STARFISH within striking distance early, steady retreat. CUP O' LUCK lost action, pulled up soon after the start, vanned off.
