CHIMAY behind the leaders toward the inside, traffic late turn, angled out three wide, bid, led, gamely late. AFTERNOON SLEW lacked early foot, slipped through along the inside and finished willingly. BOONE'S BAND bumped start, very wide drive, best of rest. SIX STRAIGHT TRICS dueled toward the inside, clear stretch, fell apart late. PEARLS AFIRE dueled for the lead off the inside, weakened the final quarter. SWEET AND FIRM bumped start, loomed four wide late in the turn and hung. NITA'S PRO picked up a couple of tiring foes after the issue had been decided. TEMPS FATE wide, no threat. CHARITY COUNTRY forward for a half, gave way. HASTY HOLLY never close.
