HEROIC CAT vied up front, fell back in the turn off the rail, came gain, kicked clear final furlong. SOUTHERN GUY narrowly set the early pace, shook clear in the turn, proved no match for the winner late, held sway for the place. LIEUTENANT ROCKET lacked speed, roused three then four wide late in the turn, finished best of the rest. HANGOVER bit tight at the start, raced well back toward the inside, swung out to be widest in the drive, stride late. J. PA within striking distance, lacked a response in the drive. JUBILEE STAR lacked a late bid. FOUR RIVERS tired from early efforts. HOLY ROMAN EMPIRE was well beaten.
