CORRUPT unhurried for six furlongs, worked his way outside late in the final turn, challenged, dug in late to prevail in game fashion. CLAYTON'S LUCK last away, trailed, moved out, fanned five wide when challenging turning for home, continued to vie past the furlong marker, outfinished. LUMBERJACK CAT behind the pace, boxed in toward the inside late in the final turn, moved out in the three path, finished up best of the rest. COOL LION alternated up front off the inside, weakened in the drive. MINER BIRD moved up inside to duel before a quarter, also gave way through the stretch. TIMELESS FACTS forwardly placed, had little left for the drive. BRONZE FOX was never involved. PACAR finished after a half.
