BEHRENS allowed the pace to go early while in hand, moved closer off the inside late on the backstretch, fell back a bit into the far turn, went back after the leader soon after and wore that rival down under a firm hand ride. LITTLEBITLIVELY dueled through rapid fractions, spurted clear into the second turn, responded when the winner came alongside and gave ground grudgingly. PRECOCITY fell far back after the start, rallied four wide into the stretch and finished best of the rest. DR FONG, void of early foot, picked up a couple of rivals while not a threat. ARCHERS BAY moved with the winner outside that one in the far turn then faltered the final quarter. TREAT ME DOC never menace outside. DIXIE ROAD dueled inside the runnerup and gave way before six furlongs.
