DUKE OF MISCHIEF away in good order, moved out to be three wide when free of traffic in the first turn, stalked from the three path in the run up the backstretch, moved to challenge on the outside in the second turn, quickly got clear, held the runner up comfortably safe in the late going. WIN WILLY lacked speed began to advance toward the inside midway on the second turn, briefly waited in traffic upper stretch, split foes through a narrow opening soon after, roused, was going well at the end while too late. JONESBORO dueled early along the inside, got clear and set a legit pace the middle half mile, proved no match when confronted by the top two in the drive, saved the show while continuing inside. DELIGHTFUL KISS fell back to trail at the start, continued well back, moved to the outside, found his best stride too late while well out in the strip. FOLLOW THE LEADER away in good order, went one pace throughout while out in the strip. PROM SHOES began to move closer after a half, angled out and was four wide late in the second turn, faltered in the run to the wire. DAKOTA PHONE dueled up front into the first turn, fell back a bit to chase in the run up the backstretch, rebid briefly in the second turn, stopped in the drive.
