SIR MOTT forwardly placed, stout restraint toward the inside, split foes late second turn when challenging, brushed with SHORTY SMALL when that one came out turning for home, gained the advantage, headed by the runner up late, came back to get the win in game fashion. GOOD TO GREAT allowed to settle, ranged up four wide to challenge four wide turning for home, challenged late, led, outfinished. ALLENSWORTH chased the leader, moved up and lodged a brief bid three wide in the final turn, weakened a bit but managed to save the show. SHORTY SMALL broke alertly, got clear to show the way, was tiring a bit when he came out turning for home, brushed, continued to weaken in the drive. COWBOY CADILLAC lacked speed, improved position into the lane, flattened out a bit the final furlong. SPOONERISM went evenly paced in lacking a late bid. CURLY CAMELI last away, trailed, passed tiring foes. DONNY'S DEMON tired after a half. LIL BOBALOO backed up through the stretch. WATCH CUPID was finished early.
