MY NEPHEW MATT took command soon after the start, set a moderate pace in hand, continued to be restrained through the turn, repulsed a bid nearing the furlong marker, clear again late. CRESRAN pressured the winner off the inside, bid, second best. ILIKEWHATIAMDOING within striking distance toward the inside, fell back the middle quarter, set down for the drive, up again for the show late. CABE forwardly placed and four wide into the turn, roused, went evenly through the stretch. NOAH'S TRAVELER in good position to strike while three wide in the turn, had nothing left in the late going. MCFADDEN off a bit slow, continued to trail through the turn, picked off a couple of tiring rivals while never a threat. EXPLOSIVE GHAZIE was outrun. SMOKING KIP backed up through the stretch.
