TREND SETTER forward and outside, pulled hard, took over turning for home, well clear, kept to task. FAITHFUL SERVANT broke well, allowed the leaders to go early, moved out, four wide into the lane, finished willingly to be clear for the place, no match for the winner. LICO lacked speed, three wide when back off the pace, roused, mild rally, finished up best of the rest. DELIVER THE STORM veered in at the start, trailed, continued well back through the turn, found best stride too late. ITALIAN MONARCH settled in mid pack, lacked a bid in the stretch. STATE LINE AVENUE lacked speed, moved out, five out to seven wide late in the turn, improved slightly while not a serious threat. LAKE BRILLIANT bothered at the start, quickly recovered to move up and contest the pace, gave way in the drive. DE ENFORCER staged a steady retreat. PYLORUS broke out, flashed speed for a half, stopped.
