BLACK CARD unhurried early, ranged up outside to challenge in the second turn, kicked well clear through the stretch. ADVANTAGE JACK prompted the pace three wide, appeared to be finished for placement in the exacta, battled back for the place while no threat to the winner. BLUE DUCK dueled up front while off the inside, proved no match for the winner in the drive, caught for the place in the late going. ANDROMEDA GARDENS saved ground to no avail. SIR RABBIT steadied when in tight along the rail and with the pace, continued to vie until a furlong remained, faltered. TACTICAL SOLUTION never a threat, well beaten. ENCHANTED HERO finished early, trailed home, far back.
