TIAGO took back at the start, continued to race well off the pace, began to move late backstretch, closer in traffic late in the final turn, angled out, stretch duel, gained the nod closest to the inside. HEATSEEKER (IRE) settled off the pace, also moved closer the third quarter, came four wide into the stretch, protracted stretch drive, missed. REPORTING FOR DUTY last away, trailed well back, staged a belated rally through some traffic, along for the show. CIRCULAR QUAY raced well back off the pace, switched out, made little impact in the drive. BUZZARDS BAY away well, forward, dueled, brief lead second turn, faltered in the drive. FAIRBANKS prompted the pace three wide, steadied when beginning to tire turning for home. SILVER LORD clear early, continued to set the pace, stopped when confronted turning for home.
