BELLE MUSE lacked speed, continued back through the turn while saving ground under some confident handling, switched out past the furlong marker, finished full of run to be in time. GATE ZAPPER behind the two leader, raced forwardly and four wide through the turn, bid between foes late, outkicked. PROPHET'S SONG broke sharp, dueled the opening quarter off the inside, shook off the other speed into the lane, clear past the furlong marker, weakened late. SWEET CONSOLIDATOR within striking distance in the early going, three wide and inside the runner up through the turn, came up empty for the drive. HATTER NU NU broke out, dueled up front inside up the backstretch, continued to vie turn, faltered in the drive. PRECIOUS PRESENT lacked speed, came four wide into the stretch, managed little in the way of a rally when the real running started. KIT CARSON broke to the inside, had little for the drive. BRINKS BABY in tight at the start, settled in mid pack, some traffic into the lane, lacked late kick. PRETTY HEIRESS forced back at the start, trailed.
