I WISHED off the pace and the inside, three wide into the lane, switched out wider past the furlong marker, with with good late energy to prove best. SHARP HARBOUR lacked speed, roused four wide out of the turn, also closed in willing fashion. HORSE FELDHAUS in the second group well out in the strip, four wide out of the turn, took over, could not contain the top two. BENAGEN well back for a half, came five wide into the the stretch, finished full of run while too late. PETTY SONG mid pack while off the inside, four wide into the stretch, improved position. CONVENTIONAL dueled up front early while racing toward but not on the inside, finished before a half. SMOKIN ART back off the pace, improved slightly while never dangerous. CONCHO broke sharp, dueled up front outside late backstretch, shook clear in the turn, folded in the drive. MARINE BAY failed to menace. JEFF AND JOHN had nothing for the drive. TOUCH OF DUTCH forwardly placed early, staged a steady retreat. MR. MONTAGU sluggish in the early going, distanced.
