Footnotes

AEGISADVANTAGE with the pace from the start, dueled through the turn closest to the inside, shook off the other speed when straightened for home, drew clear. UNCLE BRENT off the pace, came six wide out of the turn, set down, finished willingly to be up for the place. RACK DADDY broke sharp, dueled up front outside the winner turn, weakened late, caught for the place. I'M INCLUDED behind the pace, staged a mild rally toward the inside. REWIRING in the second flight, asked along late in the turn, came three wide into the stretch, brushed, finished up evenly. ONLINE CODE forwardly placed, four wide into the lane when within striking distance, brushed soon after, faded. QUARTERS five wide trip, faded in the stretch. DICTUM was never a threat. COWBOY LUKE was finished before a half.
