Footnotes

ON LOCKDOWN closest to the leader while off the inside, took over while in hand turning for home, pulled out at will, won with something left. WOULD YOU void of early foot while racing outside, rallied while continuing on the outside through the second turn, no match for the winner in the drive, clearly second best. TEXAS AIR broke in slightly, showed the way through some moderate fractions toward the inside, offered little resistance to the winner when confronted turning for home, no match for the runner up, narrowly held the show. RICKY TICK also devoid of early foot while racing out in the strip, four wide into the lane, mild rally to miss the show. KEG forwardly placed under firm restraint along the inside, continued to track the leader into the far turn, moved out a bit for the drive, came up empty when asked. DENOUEMENT bothered slightly at the start, raced back, failed to make an impact. SILENT SCORE settled in the second flight off the inside, faded after six furlongs. FRANKS ON FIRE was finished early.
