Footnotes

STATLER roughed at the start, moved up to vie closest to the inside, showed the way into and through the turn, clear into the lane, maintained daylight until late, just lasted. CANIGOTOO with the pace from the start, vied four wide through the turn, fell back off the winner into the stretch, roused, coming again late to miss. MIGHTY MONSOON bumped at the start, raced back off the pace, moved into contention by slipping through along the rail turning for home, lacked a knock out punch late while between the top two. SILVER DANDY last to leave, trailed, came six wide out of the turn when advancing, continued willingly down the middle of the strip. WHISKEY DOUBLE within striking distance, raced five wide and with the first flight in the turn, gave way. ARRIVED HOME in the second flight into and through the turn while off the inside, roused three wide into the lane, failed to muster a late kick. WHINSTON vied up front three wide for a half and began to back up. BAREFOOT MAILMAN broke in, bumped foe, raced with the pace while between foes early, stopped turning for home.
