Supplementary nominations may be made by the closing time of entries at a fee of \$2,000 which qualified to start with \$75,000 Guaranteed of which 60% to the Owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% to be divided equally between remaining starters. Weights: 122 lbs. Non-winners of \$30,000 twice allowed 3 lbs; \$30,000 once 5 lbs; \$15,000 once 7 lbs. (Maiden and Claiming races not considered.) In Allowance Stakes starting preference will be given to horses that have accumulated the highest earnings excluding money won in restricted races. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. The Owner of the winner to receive a trophy. Nominations closed Thursday, March 29, 2012 with 27 nominees.

Footnotes

GOOD DEED moved up soon after the start to vie for the lead, got clear while still hand late in the turn in the two path, pulled away under steady handling through the lane to prove clearly best. PAINTED WOMAN behind the pace in the second group outside, came four wide out of the turn, proved no match for the winner the final furlong, remained clear for the place. ALWAYS HERE TOO lacked speed for a half while racing in the two path, roused, moved out a bit when straightened for home, finished up best of the rest. FAST RESOURCE back early while racing toward the inside, came in the three path of the turn, angled out further, picked off a trio of tiring rivals late to improve position. ROCKET TWENTYONE last to leave, trailed for a half, five wide into the lane, also passed tiring foes while widest in the drive. WHOBETTERTHANUS set or forced the early pace while three wide, asked along into the lane, failed to respond, gave way from between rivals upper stretch. ALYDARLA pressured the pace four wide through the turn and faltered. STORM'S PROMISE with the pace for a half along the inside, also backed up down the stretch.
