Footnotes

LONG TO WIN lacked speed, ranged up with a strong move five wide turning for home, challenged nearing the furlong grounds, drove clear. RIGHT NOW closest to the leaders in the second flight toward the inside, closer into far turn, saved some ground into the lane, finished willingly up the rail to annex the place. SOUTHERN BLAST off the pace, challenged three wide into the stretch, vied past the furlong marker, not enough for the top two late. HAMMER SONG dueled up front along the inside, weakened in the drive. DISTINGUISHED OKIE hopped, broke awkwardly, trailed for five furlongs, showed some belated interest while out in the strip. ZELLERS dueled up front while off the inside, gave way in the drive. CHASENTHEGOLD settled off the pace and the rail, lacked a response in the drive. HIGHER broke alertly, chased the leaders early, began a steady retreat after a half. ROYAL RUDE BOY was finished early. DOUBLE DOWN DELTA was also through early.
