RIVER CRUISING jostled at the start, advanced up the inside to join the second flight, angled out for wide entering the turn, rallied, in time outside. HILARIUM broke out to bother outer rivals, was straightened quickly and dueled closest to the inside, disposed of the other speed late by late in the turn, could not contain the winner. BARBER SHOP ROCK bumped at the start, raced back, came six wide into the lane, staged a mild rally to annex the show. BASONE outrun in the early going, improved position in the turn, flattened out a bit in the drive. WILDER DAYS settled in mid pack early, steadied into the turn, fell back a bit, lacked a significant late response. SYNCHRONICITY TOO in the second flight early, had nothing for the drive. SILVER POSSE well back at the start, moved out to be widest of all for the drive, improved position a bit, not a serious threat. ARNIE never menaced. SUSPECTING GOLD bothered star the start, recovered to duel inside, gave way late in the turn. ANOTHER AFLEET tired while racing four wide.
