TRADITIONALLY came in at the start, settled toward the inside off a blistering early pace, ranged up at will to challenge late in the second turn, drew out under confident handling to win ridden out. MR ROSS fell well back out in the strip, began a belated rally turning for home, up for the place late while not a threat to the winner. WOODEN PHONE broke on top, stepped through a suicidal pace duel along the inside, responded briefly turning for home when the winner approached, caught for the place late. GRAEME HALL off the pace and the rail, loomed up four wide to contend turning for home, flattened out. SIR BEAR bothered at the start, moved closer toward the inside with a quarter to run, little left late. FAN THE FLAME blistering pace duel off the inside, weakened in the drive. MAYSVILLE SLEW bothered at the start, never close while trailing throughout.
