SPANISH EMPIRE prompted the early pace three wide, vied on the outside into the far turn, put a head in front turning for home, proved determined in the drive. CRAFTY SHAW showed the way along the inside through some moderate splits, displaced turning for home, came back for the place while continuing inside. NO COMPRENDE hard rated along the inside for five furlongs, fell back a bit into the far turn, moved out, challenged three wide upper stretch, hung late, outfinished for the place. MISSME rated behind the pace, loomed outside turning for home, failed to follow through. ASK THE LORD failed to seriously menace. RIVER MOUNTAIN RD lacked a significant rally. GIMMEAWINK pressed pace, gave way. GO LEGS GO was finished early.
