GREEN GLORY void of early foot toward the inside, moved out a bit in upper stretch, set down, finished up willingly to be in time for the place. ST. VICKIE'S CHARM behind the pace, loomed a threat four wide turning for home, hung in the drive. KISS ME CHOCOLATE prompted the pace between foes, had little for the drive. MISSY BISCUIT void of speed, trailed turn, passed tiring foes after the issue had been decided. CLASS E HOLIDAY tired after a half. SAND PLUM broke alertly, set a quick opening quarter, gave way. RANSOM ZIP prompted the pace for four furlongs, backed up through the stretch.
