SUNNY STEIN broke out but alertly, set the pace toward the inside, shrugged off the other speed to be well clear into the lane, kept to task down the lane. EXPECTING MONEY away in good order, closest to the winner while off the inside, could do little with that foe in the drive, remained clear for the place. SO LONG JULIE settled off the pace and the inside, switched out to the middle of the strip, up late for the show. CHELAN ECHO off the early pace, staged a mild rally into the lane while four wide, flattened out a bit late, caught final strides for the show. MISS LILY MAE void of early foot, continued to trail into the turn, staged a mild rally through traffic while never dangerous. KAT'S TRIP forwardly placed in the early going, faded. THEATRE OF DREAMS well back in the early going, improved into the lane, flattened out the final furlong. YANKEEDOODLE CANDY five wide turning for home, never menaced. CAROL'S CANDLE was always outrun. DANCING RUTH steadily faded. TRU OMEGA was finished early.
