Footnotes

KENNY BOY lacked speed, continued back into the far turn, made a strong move six wide turning for home to reach contention, kicked down leader. WESTERN SUN broke well, allowed the pace to go early, continued to stalk up the backstretch, took over three wide turning for home, got clear and toward the inside, could not contain the winner. GARMENTO pinched back at the start, off the pace, four wide into the far turn, advanced five wide into the lane, finished up best of the rest. LANGALEER fell well back off the pace, advanced five wide and in some traffic exiting the final turn, flattened out a bit in the final furlong to finish up evenly. FLAG INDY void of speed, trailed through the second turn, six wide turning for home, improved position. THE BAY PHANTOM four wide through the first turn, settled, ranged up to challenge outside the runner up while continuing four wide in the second turn, faltered in the drive. JACK KNIFE settled off the pace, five wide and in some traffic in the second turn, failed to respond in the drive. FLEXNOW evenly paced, had little for the drive. MACH TWELVE pushed out start, vied early while between foes, continued to contest the issue up front in the run up the backstretch, gave way late in the second turn. COWBOY LUKE broke out, bothered outer rivals, set or forced the pace closest to the inside for five furlongs and gave way. ANARCHY vied up front outside for six furlongs and stopped.
