BUZZARDS BAY got out a bit just after the start, set a lively pace in the two path, garnered a larger advantage turning for home, kept to task with a right handed stick while increasing his margin down the stretch in a sharp effort. MAGNUM (ARG) lacked early foot, continued back and in traffic turning for home, dropped to the inside for room, up for the place while no threat to the winner. GOULDINGS GREEN slight steady in tight quarters into the first turn, tracked the pace toward the inside, gave up the rail to the runner up turning for home, outfinished for the place spot. MASTER COMMAND four wide throughout while being encouraged slightly, set down for the drive, lacked a significant late response. WITH DISTINCTION prompted the winner for almost a mile, weakened. IT'S NO JOKE saved ground while well off the pace, bothered slightly turning into the stretch when in tight, failed to respond after recovering. PURIM was never a factor. ANDROMEDA'S HERO trailed throughout in a dull effort.
