### Footnotes

TOTAL BULL last to leave, moved up to track the leader after moving out a bit, engaged that foe when straightened for home, gained a clear advantage briefly inside the furlong grounds, kept briskly to task to hold the runner up safe late. FLYING PRIVATE firmly rated along the inside behind the top two, fell back a bit early in the second turn while still under restraint, moved out, roused for the drive, steady gain late while appearing to lug in a bit, finished up willingly. CRYPTOLIGHT settled off the pace and the inside, continued to race at an even pace into the lane when fanned four wide, lacked a significant late response to challenge the top two, saved the show. GRAND SENSATION away in good order, set the pace along the inside, continued to set the pace under slight restraint in the run up the backstretch, responded briefly when challenged nearing the furlong grounds, faltered when headed. KENTUCKY MAN settled off the pace, lacked a late, kick. UNO MAS fell back to trail, was not involved.
