SCAMP AND A HALF closest to the leader, collared that one exiting the turn, drove well clear. PROPHECY off the pace, moved closer along the inside, split foes after angling out, closed willingly to earn the place. EGO MANIA broke sharp, soon got clear, set the pace, faltered when headed. MISS NEWFIE forwardly placed, came up empty for the drive. COURTESAN'S SONG went evenly throughout in lacking a late bid. DANCING DUDETE also lacked a late kick. ELEGANT SCAM made little impact while racing outside. YIKES raced mid pack, in some traffic turn, had little for the drive. HALF A SPLASH last away, was never involved. HAMILTON PROSPECT stopped after a half, eased stretch, returned bleeding.
