HOTRUNNINWATER forwardly placed off the inside, took over in the three path late in the turn, set down for the drive, edged away while fully extended. LEE CREEK bothered slightly at the start, used early to move up, four wide turn, challenged inside the winner turning for home, gave ground grudgingly to that foe, clearly second best. T. THOMAS lacked speed, fanned six wide out of the turn, staged a modest rally down the middle of the strip, finished up best of the rest. CALHOUN STONEWALL went evenly paced throughout in lacking a late bid. DORVAN off the pace along the inside, lacked a late kick. STELLAR EXPLOSION last to leave, void of early foot, improved position while not a serious threat. SMART REALITY had little for the drive. DAVMAR THREE off the pace, improved position in some traffic upper stretch, flattened back out late. GOOD BY JESTER brushed at the start, was never a threat. HAYDAY'S PAYDAY narrowly set the pace, stopped when headed turning for home. MARKED TEXAN vied up front in the early off the inside, also stopped.
