AWESOME BET outrun for six furlongs, continued well back far turn, swung out to be five wide into the stretch, closed with a rush to be well clear late. FORGOTTEN KNOT settled off the leaders, saved all the ground, continued to run the rail stretch, finished willingly to be in time for the place. BLUEGRASS JAM in the second flight, moved closer on the outside turning for home, failed to sustain that effort the final furlong. STOUT HOPE showed the way into the first turn, continued to set pace, clear far turn, weakened when confronted in the late going. QUIET ASSAULT vied early, chased the leader into the far turn, weakened. ROAD MAN last away, trailed throughout, showed little in a dull effort.
